




Africa (Hardback)

The final chapter in each book features a scientist, related to the continent, with specialties that range from dinosaurs to the study of volcanoes. Africa is a continent of 53 countries and is home to people who make up more than 800 ethnic groups. More than 5,000 years ago, the country of Egypt, located in northern Africa, was one of the world s greatest civilizations. Africa is the land of the Sahara, the world s largest desert. It also hosts the Democratic Republic of Congo, which has one of the world s thickest rain forests.
